You, and perhaps the Mayor, some other Councillors and our MPs, appear to be under the impression that Tomaree Ratepayers and Residents Association inc. (TRRA) is some sort of 'front' for political parties such as the Greens or Labor.

Far from it – to the best of my knowledge (TRRA doesn't ask), I am the only Greens member active in TRRA (although not on the Committee), and my impression is that a majority of TRRA members would lean towards the conservative side of politics.
