



## FORESHORE PLANS UNRAVELED

The newly-formed Tomaree Ratepayers and Residents Association (TRRA) will provide a valuable opportunity for discussion of the future redevelopment plans of the Port Stephens and Nelson Bay foreshores.

A meeting, to be held on Monday 31 March at 7.30 p.m. at the Nelson Bay Bowling Club, is the first action meeting planned by TRRA.

The guest speaker will be the Project Manager from the Lands Department, Keith Southall, who will outline the Management Plans and address community concerns.

The meeting will address the Nelson Bay Foreshore Plan, covering the area from the Nelson Bay Marina to Fly Point, which has just been adopted by the Minister for Lands. It will also cover the Port Stephens Foreshore Plan which has recently been instigated by the Department to extend from Corlette to Shoal Bay.

These plans will have far reaching impacts on the Tomaree community.

This is an opportunity for all residents to learn more about them and discuss their impact on the area.

The Tomaree Ratepayers and Residents Association was formed at a lively inaugural meeting on 3 March, attended by almost ninety concerned persons. TRRA aims to provide a voice for the community in addressing issues that impact on it. Over the forthcoming months other important local developments and issues will be considered.
